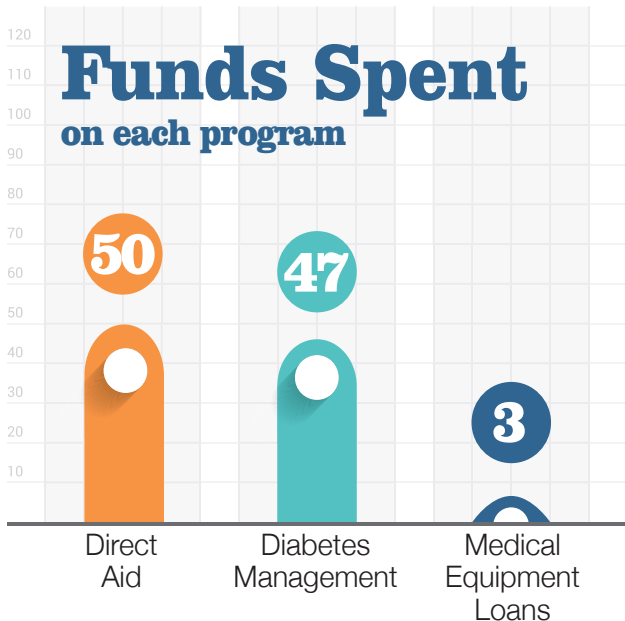

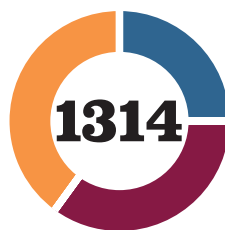


Funds Spent on each program

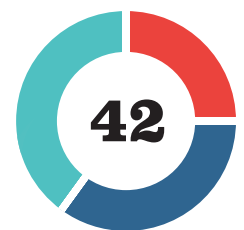
